Adrian Vevera has been the General Director of the National Institute for Research and Development in Informatics – ICI since 2020. The institute's mission is to promote excellence in research and innovation to develop a knowledge-based economy and to integrate Romania into the global research community.

Mr. Vevera joined ICI in 2017 as a Member of the Scientific Council of the institution, becoming a Senior Researcher (Scientific grade II) in 2018. Since 2023, he has been the Vice President of the International Council for Information Technology in Government Administration (ICA), a non-profit international association that promotes and facilitates the informal exchange of ideas, knowledge, and experiences regarding the management and use of information and communication technologies (ICT) in central government administration.

Mr. Vevera worked as an Associate Lecturer at the Polytechnic University of Bucharest, where he taught the course “Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity” between 2017 and 2020 as part of the English-language master's program “Advanced Cybersecurity.”

Previously, he held numerous advisory positions in national security, served for a period as Director of the National Cyber Incident Response Centre – CERT-RO, and was Chairman and member of the Board of Directors at Transelectrica SA.

Mr. Vevera holds a PhD in Military Sciences and Intelligence from the National Intelligence Academy "Mihai Viteazul," several certificates from national security and defence courses from the same institution, and a law degree from "Titu Maiorescu" University.
