## Minister of Economy, Digitalization, Entrepreneurship, and Tourism

Bogdan Ivan is the Minister of Economy, Digitalization, Entrepreneurship, and Tourism in the Government of Romania, playing a key role in promoting the country's economic and digital development. With over 10 years of experience in public administration and IT&C, Mr. Ivan oversees the development and implementation of national strategies that support economic growth, the expansion of digital services, SME support, and national promotion. He represents Romania in the European Union and other international forums on issues related to the Ministry's broad portfolio.

Previously, he served as Minister of Research, Innovation, and Digitalization, and was elected as a Member of Parliament and Vice President of the IT&C Committee in the Romanian Parliament. Within that role, he contributed to the legislative framework and oversight of the IT&C sector in Romania. Notably, he initiated the Interoperability Law (No. 242 of July 20, 2022), which regulates data exchange between IT systems and established the National Interoperability Platform—legislation designed to eliminate paper-based bureaucracy and provide a common technical language for public institutions.

Mr. Ivan holds a degree in Public Administration from the Faculty of Political, Administrative and Communication Sciences at Babeş-Bolyai University in Cluj-Napoca. He also completed a Master's program in Communication and Public Relations at the same institution. He earned a PhD in Sociology from the Doctoral School of Sociology at the University of Bucharest, with a dissertation titled "Aspects of Romania's Organizational Specificity. Socio-organizational Models for Updating Human Resource Policies Among Civil Servants."

He is passionate about leveraging cutting-edge tools to improve quality of life, social cohesion, and economic competitiveness in Romania and across the EU. He believes in working with integrity, transparency, and collaboration to achieve the best outcomes for the public interest.
